Community Support

Commonwealth Home Support Program

Eligibility: People over 65 years or 50 years of age for Aboriginal & Torres Straight Islander people.

Assessment: Yes

Community Care staff can help with your referral.

Support available:

Community Transport; is a personalised door-to-door transport service to medical appointments, social activities, shopping and visiting friends. Carers are welcome to travel.

Meals on Wheels; offers a range of meal choices which meet dietary needs and are culturally appropriate, freshly cooked meals delivered Mon to Sat, sandwiches and Salads, fruit salads, vegie and meat packs, breakfast & dinner boxes plus a wide range of frozen meal choices.

Assistance with heating and serving a delivered meal, prompting or assisting with eating and drinking if not part of a personal care service.

Respite Brokered Service; will support carers to have time out from their caring role.

Social Support: Offers a friendly home visit, assistance with shopping, accompanying clients to medical appointments, daily telephone monitoring, support to attend social activities and help with bill paying and letter writing.

Availability: Once Community Care receives a request for service support from My Aged Care. Clients will be contacted so support can be put in place to meet their particular circumstances.

Cost: This will be discussed before support commences.

Transport Disadvantaged

Eligibility: A person who requires a transport service for medical, social, or shopping purposes and is not eligible to receive transport services under another government program.

A person who has limited or no access to private or public transport due to their location, time of travel, their financial resources and their physical and cognitive capacities.

Assessment: Yes - Community Care Centre.

Service Type: Travel Vouchers for local transport.

Community Bus to Dubbo each Monday, door to door pick up.

Availability: Book travel and pick up vouchers from the Community Care Centre.

Cost: This will be discussed before support commences.

Community Care Support Program

Eligibility: People with a disability under 65 or under 50 years of age if identifying as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander.

Assessment: Yes Call into the Community Care Centre or ring 6817 8750 to enquire.

Support available: Travel for medical, social and recreational purposes.

Bookings: Yes.

Availability: Once you have been assessed the support you need will be put in place.

Cost: This will be discussed before support commences.

NOTE: This Program is currently transitioning to the NDIS. Please consult with the local Transport Service Provider for more information on other services available.

Travel Vouchers A book of 10 vouchers are available to support special needs groups, financially disadvantage people and young people.
